Obituary

Candice's son Alex passed away in 2020.

The Mosgroves' relocated to Gulfport, MS in 1976. Candice graduated from Gulfport High School. Sometime during the mid eighties, "Candie" moved with her mother and brothers to Buffalo, NY. Candice is described by her brother John as being beautiful, very outgoing, intelligent, good at crafts, and loved being with friends. She was open to everyone!

In 2006 Candice moved to Rochester, NY. When she had no where else to go, Candice came to House of Mercy at 725 Hudson Avenue. The House of Mercy was the place Candice called home. She was always welcome when other places were not an option. Candice was a beloved member of the House of Mercy family; where she experienced love and acceptance.

Candice especially enjoyed being present whenever we held Mass. It was obvious that Candice loved the Lord and wanted to join in on the prayers and songs as well as dancing joyfully before the Lord.

Candice's brother John revealed that the family lost contact with Candice when she moved to Rochester. In 2018 Candice was renting a room at the Cadillac Hotel. In June the Cadillac Hotel was forced to close, this was a terrible blow to the residents who resided there for years, including Candice.

House of Mercy led the protest against the closing of this hotel. Candice joined the demonstrations. "Candie's" family recognized her in the media reports and learned of her connection with House of Mercy.

Candice departed from her earthly life April 20, 2021.
